nacom. Ocean View was a largely working-class area, unlike the community around the university. In between was open land owned by farmers who wanted the freedom to work their land.

"But all agreed that they didn't want to be annexed by Oakland," Finacom said.

Oakland was said to have a large public debt, and no one wanted to pay the heavy taxes needed to pay off those bills. So in 1878, unification was approved.

"The community of Ocean View grew towards the hills and the university community grew towards the rest of Berkeley," said Sally Sachs, president of Berkeley Architectural Heritage Association.

The city was named after Bishop George Berkeley, who

BERKELEY — Bernard Maybeck and Julia Morgan were two of the greatest architects of any era but it was Berkeley's good fortune to have them both at the same time.

She was his star pupil. Together they turned Berkeley into the city of shingle-style homes it is today.

Maybeck was born in 1862 in Greenwich Village, the son of an immigrant wood carver. His father sent him to the Ecole des Beaux Arts in Paris to study furniture design, but he soon switched to his true calling, architecture. In 1889, he returned to the U.S. and settled in Berkeley.
