### TESTING AT THE FIRE FIGHTING SCHOOL, SAN DIEGO

The approval of the test plan dated January 6, 1991, entitled "Navy Fire Fighter Emissions Test Plan", and submitted by Dr. Robert S. Levine, Building and Fire Research, National Institutes for Standards and Technology, is hereby rescinded.

Data submitted in test reports to the San Diego APCD have not satisfied the requirements of California Air Resources Board (CARB) Method 429. The quality control data is inadequate. In addition, the testing parameters agreed to in the test plan, and in various conversations and meetings, have been remiss. Requirements for testing also include testing for "criteria pollutants". Currently, no test plan has been submitted to do this testing at the San Diego facilities.

Therefore, it serves the interests of the Navy and the San Diego APCD that testing is not allowed at this time.
