**Availability of Administrative Record File for Naval Training  
Center, San Diego, California**

The U.S. Navy announces the availability of the complete administrative record file for NTC's Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) actions. The administrative record includes documents which the U.S. Navy uses to select a remedial or removal (environmental cleanup) action at NTC. Documents now in the record file include site assessment and investigation reports and the community relations plan. Other documents will be added to the file as work at NTC progresses, including comments submitted by interested persons, U.S. Navy responses to substantive comments, and Restoration Advisory Board information.

In addition, the administrative record file for the Inactive Landfill at NTC (site 1) has been established at the San Diego Central Library and documents pertaining to environmental actions at this site are available for public review. The Inactive Landfill was used between the late 1940's and 1971 to dispose refuse from day-to-day operations of the Marines Corps Recruit Depot (MCRD) and NTC. The U.S. Navy seeks to inform the public of the availability of the record file at this repository and to encourage the public to comment on documents as they are placed in the record.
