
**RE: DRAFT REMOVAL ACTION SITE CLOSEOUT REPORT, SITE 14, FORMER

The Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) has completed review of the above referenced document, dated November 16, 1999. The report describes the activities performed for the remediation of contaminated soils located at the site. The document was prepared by Foster Wheeler Environmental Corp., on behalf of Southwest Division Naval Facilities Engineering Command (SWDIV). Based on our review of the subject document the RWQCB confirms the completion of a site investigation and remedial action for Site 14, (POI 29, Former Small Arms Range No. 2) former Naval Training Center. Thank you for your cooperation throughout this investigation. Based on this information the RWQCB has determined that the site does not present a significant threat to existing or probable future beneficial uses of the waters of state in the vicinity of the site.

Therefore, based on the available information, including the current land use and with the provision that the information provided to this agency was accurate and representative of site conditions, **no further action** related to this site is required.
