**DEPARTMENT OF TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL REVIEW AND COMMENT ON THE
DRAFT - COMMUNITY RELATIONS PLAN (DATED NOVEMBER 22, 1991) FOR THE
NAVAL STATION TREASURE ISLAND, CALIFORNIA**

On November 27, 1991 the Department received a copy of the above draft report. The Department has reviewed the above document prepared by PRC Environmental Management Inc. (PRC) for the Navy. The Department has prepared the following comments:

COMMENTS

1. The report submitted was labeled incorrectly, the report is a "Draft" not a "Draft Final".
2. Change all DHS (Department of Health Services) acronyms to DTSC (Department of Toxic Substances Control).
3. The plan does not state which agencies have responsibility or oversight for the community relations activities.
4. Provide an area map, or modify Figure 1 to include the surrounding area.
5. The plan does not describe the history of the community interest or involvement in the site.
6. Provide a list of locations for public meetings.
7. Submit the mailing list on a separate binder independent from the plan; however, the plan must include the names and addresses of all the active agencies directly involved with this project.
8. Do not attribute comments to individuals who were interviewed. Provide comments, not names.

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9. Do not make assumptions/presumptions on the significance or insignificance of groundwater utilization by humans and/or wildlife. State the facts supporting potential site contamination without making judgement calls, otherwise delete from plan.
10. Public meetings, community workshops, and briefings were not seen as the most effective methods of involving interested persons. What were the recommendations made by the interviewees in meeting the public information needs.
11. Describe the effective community relations effort that will be implemented to channel a conflict toward a useful purpose.
12. Amend the Community Relations Activities Throughout The IR Program (Figure 2) to include a 30 day Public Comment Period in the Draft RAP.
13. Make the following changes/amendments to the mailing list:
 - a) Roberta Hough is from the APEN organization.
 - b) Dwight R. Hoenig, Chief has been replaced by Howard K. Hatayama, Regional Administrator.
 - c) City of Oakland Mayor Lionel Wilson has been replaced by Mayor Elihu Harris.
 - d) Assemblyman 13th District, Honorable Elihu Harris has been replaced by the Honorable Barbara Lee.
13. Add the DTSC File Room at 700 Heinz Avenue, Building "F", Berkeley, California 94710 to the Repositories in Appendix B of the plan.
