I appreciate the interest you have shown in an evaluation of the groundwater sampling practices at Treasure Island Naval Station. Per your request, the U.S. EPA will: (1) review the Quality Assurance Project Plan (1991) and the Field Sampling Plan (1991) and; (2) conduct a field evaluation of the groundwater sample collection activities including split sampling.

The objective of this evaluation is to work with the BCT to improve data quality. This evaluation is meant to be a cooperative effort and is not for enforcement purposes.

We would like to conduct the field oversight activities upon the next round of quarterly sampling scheduled for May 1, 1995.
