Naval Station Treasure Island
Additional Community Membership Openings
for the Environmental Restoration Advisory Board

Naval Station Treasure Island, located in the bay between San Francisco and Oakland, will close September 30, 1997. This will be part of the Department of Defense program to close military bases across the country and to help convert them to non-military uses. As a result of past military operations, some environmental cleanup is necessary on portions of the property before these areas can be transferred.

To assist the Navy in the cleanup effort, the US Government requires a high level of public involvement through a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) comprised of citizen volunteers and representatives from local, state and federal regulatory agencies. The RAB is intended to bring together the general public and government representatives to reflect the community's broad range of interests in Naval Station Treasure Island. There are no special skills or qualifications to be a community member of the RAB other than a strong interest in the Navy's cleanup program.

The job of the RAB is to review and offer recommendations about the Navy's proposed cleanup plans. The Treasure Island RAB was formed in 1994 and has been meeting regularly. Due to turnover in membership, additional community members are needed to serve on the board. The RAB meets monthly, usually on the 4th Tuesday of the month at 7:00 PM, on Treasure Island.

The application deadline is Friday June 2, 1995. Applications can be obtained by calling or writing the address below. The next meeting of the Treasure Island RAB is scheduled for Tuesday, May 23, 1995 at 7:00 PM at the Fleet Admiral Nimitz Conference Center, Building 140. Future meeting dates are June 27, July 25, August 22 and September 26. All meetings are open to the general public.
