Pursuant to our telephone conversation today regarding my letter, 5090, Ser 1832.5/L6005, dated October 4, 1995, I would like to clarify further the status of the Clipper Cove Skeet Range investigation.

The funding for Clipper Cove Skeet Range investigation was obligated in fiscal year (FY) 95. The skeet range investigation is part of Phase II Ecological Risk Assessment (EA). The draft Phase II EA Work Plan dated December 19, 1994 (not December 19, 1995 as stated in October 4, 1995 letter) was submitted and reviewed by regulatory agencies. The Navy is preparing the draft final work plan for your review. Field work for the skeet range will commence upon approval of the final work plan.
