An interim draft final work plan was prepared and submitted to the BRAC Cleanup Team (BCT) in July 1995 for review due to the revised approach. The BCT held a working group meeting on August 14, 1995 to discuss the interim draft final Phase II EA work plan. Comments from the BCT and regulatory agencies are presented as Appendix C of the work plan. All additions to the work plan have been redlined and all deletions have been marked by ~~strikeout~~.
