



1. Enclosure (1) is provided for your review and comments. Please provide your comments to the Navy on or before 18 October 1999. This document addressed the completed interim removal actions for the lead-contaminated soil near Building 1133 at Site 12.
2. The removal action was initiated to meet the 15 September 1999 scheduled occupancy of Building 1135 and 1 October 1999 scheduled occupancy for Building 1131 which are located near Building 1133. The decision for the interim removal action (IRA) was made in the 8 September 1998 Treasure Island Meeting of the RPMs, BCT, Navy management, and regulatory agencies' management teams. The decision was to excavate up to 4 feet and the limits of the excavation based on physical boundaries rather on confirmation sampling.
