**IDENTIFICATION OF STATE "APPLICABLE" OR "RELEVANT AND APPROPRIATE"
REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR INSTALLATION
RESTORATION SITE 31, FORMER SOUTH STORAGE YARD, NAVAL STATION
TREASURE ISLAND, SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA**

Dear Ms. Landers:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received the Navy's letter, dated May 19, 2006, that formally requested that DTSC identify potential State chemical-specific, location-specific, and action-specific applicable or relevant and appropriate requirements (ARARs) for potential remedial actions for Installation Restoration Site 31 at Naval Station Treasure Island. All State ARARs identified would be considered and evaluated during the preparation of the Feasibility Study (FS).

After considering the Navy's request for State ARARs for the Site 31 FS, DTSC, acting as the lead regulatory agency for the State of California, has determined that it would be acceptable to apply the ARARs that were developed for the Site 30 FS to Site 31. DTSC made this determination based on the similarities between the two sites (i.e., contaminants of concern, site configuration, including paving and buildings, and the types of reuses) and with the understanding that the identification of ARARs by other

State entities would likely result in the same list of ARARs previously identified for Site 30. Therefore, please consider the ARARs previously identified for Site 30 as potential ARARs for Site 31.
