Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has received the June 22, 2007 *Site Management Plan* (SMP) for the former Naval Station Treasure Island (NSTI), San Francisco, California. The SMP provides (a) the annual status of the strategies for ongoing environmental programs, and (b) an update to the schedules presented in the Federal Facility Site Remediation Agreement (FFSRA) for NSTI. DTSC acknowledges the receipt of the SMP.


DTSC and the Navy used a draft version of the SMP schedule and finalized the California January 2007 Joint Execution Plan on May 2, 2007. Hence, the Navy has met the requirement to update the FFSRA schedule annually.

The cleanup strategies in the SMP are an important preliminary evaluation of possible contamination and responses for a wide variety of sites and site types. However, such strategies are subject to change as site-specific projects progress. The SMP is informative in categorizing most of the NSTI's environmental issues. Please continue to prepare the SMP annually to assist FFSRA schedule updates.
