Hi Danielle,

I reviewed the draft Human Health Risk Assessment Addendum for IR Site 21. I have no significant comments to add to those that DTSC and AMEC have already submitted.

I do have a minor comment, however, to help with understanding of the evaluation of pathways: on p. 8-1, paragraph 3, instead of "Groundwater is not used, as it had been declared nonbeneficial use . . .", write: "Groundwater is not used for drinking water or irrigation, as it has received a beneficial use exemption . . ."

Also, please check the headers for Tables 3, 4 and 5 about the screening levels, and remove the typo in the header (It currently says Carcinogenic Effects/ Carcinogenic Effects on all the headers instead of Carcinogenic Effects/ Noncarcinogenic Effects).
