Hi Myriam, Keith, and Kimberly,

To provide some context on Myriam's specific comment #2 regarding potential future ecological habitat at Site 32: I've attached the sea level rise adaptation strategy figure for Treasure Island, showing certain areas which, as a contingency if SLR is greater than planned, could be adapted into tidal marshland areas. Site 32 is not one of these areas. Also, while a freshwater wetland is being considered near the future wastewater treatment plant, the development plans do not show it within Site 32. The 2011 development plan shows the wetland bordering or slightly entering Site 6, so the language in the Site 6 ROD was appropriate, but I think this is not the case for Site 32.




FIGURE 6.4 SEA LEVEL RISE STRATEGY SITE PLAN DIAGRAM





FIGURE 6.6 SEA LEVEL RISE SECTION C
