Notice of Availability of Record of Decision/Final Remedial Action Plan for IR Site 32, Former Training and Storage Area, Former Naval Station Treasure Island

San Francisco, California The Department of the Navy announces the release of the Record of Decision (ROD)/Final Remedial Action Plan (RAP) for Installation Restoration (IR) Site 32, the former training and storage area at Former Naval Station Treasure Island. IR Site 32 encompasses 2.6 acres on the northeastern edge of Treasure Island. The ROD/Final RAP presents the Navy's no further action determination for chemicals in soil and groundwater. The ROD/Final RAP does not address potential radiological contamination within Site 32. The ROD/Final RAP was signed by the Navy, the Department of Toxic Substances Control, and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board in April 2016.

The Navy's no further action determination was presented to the public for review in the Proposed Plan/Draft RAP for Site 32. The no further action determination was based on removal of contaminated soil and treatment of contaminated groundwater in a previous cleanup action that occurred at Site 32 in 2009 and 2010. The public was invited to comment on the Proposed Plan/Draft RAP for Site 32 during a 30-day public comment period and at a public meeting in September 2011. No public comments were received.
