In accordance with the requirements of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), the Navy invites public comment on a removal action that was completed as a time-critical removal action on the Army Adelphi Research Laboratory (ARL) property, the Site W Swale, which is located adjacent to the former NSWC White Oak Installation Restoration (IR) Site 46. Construction has been completed. The project addressed groundwater discharges originating from the former NSWC White Oak into a surface stream.

Public comment will begin on December 2, 1998 and close on December 31, 1998 (30 days after the opening date).
